Facility and Service Updates

Pulaski Memorial Hospital has implemented numerous precautions to mitigate the spread and impact of the novel coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19). Additional safety measures are now in place to protect patients and co-workers while resuming operations.

These measures include:

- Additional patient screenings via phone before the day of care and upon arrival to a PMH facility.
- Enhanced the ability of patients and associates to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer.
- Contained areas for patients with known or suspected COVID-19.
- Enhanced cleaning procedures of high touch areas that include the use of UV light sterilization in some areas.

Ongoing precautions include:

- All individuals will be asked to wear a face mask and have their temperature taken upon entering a PMH facility. Patients are encouraged to wear their own masks, but those without a mask will be given one upon arrival.
- Ongoing visitor restrictions and limited entrances to the hospital and clinics.
- To maintain social distancing practices, patients may be directed back to their vehicle to wait until their scheduled appointment.
- Drivers and caregivers will be directed to wait in their vehicles while the patient is in their appointment. PMH will contact drivers and caregivers once the patient is ready to be picked up.

These practices are in place at all PMH facilities.
