

# Visitor Restrictions

**EFFECTIVE: 07/16/2021**

**Pulaski Memorial Hospital is taking steps to protect our patients, their families, and staff by temporarily limiting visitation in our hospital. Visitor restrictions have been put into place to help minimize the spread of respiratory illnesses such as Influenza and COVID-19.**

**All patients and visitors will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms and have their temperature taken. All visitors must wear a mask while in the hospital.**

- Inpatients on our Medical/Surgical Ward may have two (2) visitors at any time. Minors must be accompanied by an adult. Visitors may come and go freely throughout the day. Rotating visitors should remain outside until previous visitors leave. Visitation hours will be between 7:00 AM - 9:00 PM. Visitors of COVID-19 positive patients must wear appropriate personal protective equipment.
- Pediatric Patients may have both parents/legal guardians present at a time. Two (2) additional visitors may come and go freely at any time. Minors must be accompanied by an adult. Rotating visitors should remain outside until previous visitors leave. Visitation hours will be between 7:00 AM - 9:00 PM.
- OB Patients may have one (1) adult support person remain with them during delivery. After delivery, two (2) visitors, may visit at any time. Minors must be accompanied by an adult. Visitors may come and go freely throughout the day. Rotating visitors should remain outside until previous visitors leave. Visitation hours will be between 7:00 AM - 9:00 PM.
- Patients receiving Outpatient procedures may have one (1) support person with them throughout the procedure.
- Emergency Department patients may have one (1) support person to assist with additional consent needs and discharge. Additional visitors may be allowed depending on clinical resources.
- If a patient is critically or terminally ill, a nurse manager or charge nurse for the unit may allow additional visitors. Visitors will be limited to two (2) people at a time. Rotating visitors should wait outside until previous visitors leave.

**The Nursing Staff or Physician On Duty will ultimately determine if visitation can be accommodated.**
